<p>HT1: Human Growth and Development Across Life Stages</p> <p>Pupils are introduced to PIES (physical, intellectual, emotional and social development) and are introduced to the first few developmental life stages of infancy and early childhood. Pupils will learn how growth and development changes.</p>	<p>HT2: Human Growth and Development Across Life Stages</p> <p>Pupils continue learning about PIES development. They will explore the further four life stages and learn how growth and development changes throughout a person's life.</p>	<p>HT1: Health Care, Social Care, Barriers to Health and Social Care</p> <p>Pupils are introduced to different types of health and social care services. They will explore a range of these, and will learn how they work together. They will also learn how some people may have barriers to these services, and how they can be overcome.</p>	<p>HT2: Skills, Values and Attributes in Health and Social Care, Obstacles and Benefits of Health and Social Care</p> <p>Pupils are introduced to different skills, attributes and values a health and social care worker needs, and why these are important. They also learn what happens if needs aren't met.</p>
<p>HT3: Factors Affecting Growth and Development, Different Types of Life Event and Coping with Change</p> <p>Pupils learn how different factors and life events may affect someone's growth and development in different life stages. They also learn how support and character traits may help them adapt to change.</p>	<p>HT4: Component 1 PSA</p> <p>Pupils will start their first piece of coursework (Person Set Assignment, PSA). The PSA covers all of component 1 and is about human lifespan development.</p>	<p>HT3: Component 2 PSA</p> <p>Pupils will start their second piece of coursework (Person Set Assignment, PSA). The PSA covers all of component 2 and is about health and social care services and values. In this half term, they will also finish and submit it.</p>	<p>HT4: Health and Wellbeing</p> <p>Pupils are introduced to factors which affect health and wellbeing and will look how lifestyle and physiological indicators can help assess health. They will also look at different types of action and care plans health and social care services may provide patients.</p>
<p>HT5: Component 1 PSA</p> <p>Pupils will continue their first piece of coursework (Person Set Assignment, PSA). The PSA covers all of component 1 and is about human lifespan development.</p>	<p>HT6: Component 1 PSA</p> <p>Pupils will complete and submit their first piece of coursework (Person Set Assignment, PSA). The PSA covers all of component 1 and is about human lifespan development.
