Spring 1 – Run, Run as Fast as You Can!

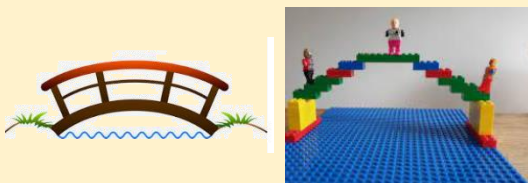


Please choose **2** of the following projects to complete linked to our topic this term; Run, Run as Fast as You Can!

Alternatively, if you have a burning desire to complete a different related project, you can surprise your teacher with that instead.

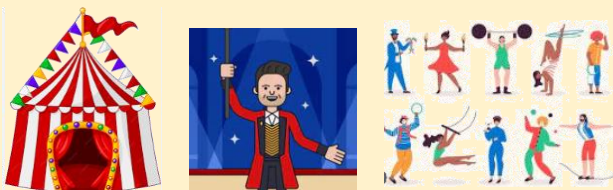
Option 1: Bridge building

Option 3: Playground fun

Go on a visit to the park and think about the different movements needed on the playground equipment.

Can you 'pull' yourself up as you climb the climbing frame?

Can you 'push' the roundabout?

Can you 'swing' on the swings (by yourself or with a little help?)

Can you 'slide' down the slide?



Option 4: Being helpful

Our stories this half term are all about being good friends and helping each other – could you send a photograph in of you helping someone else or being a good friend?



Key vocabulary:
