This term's topic overview... 'What a Wonderful World!'

- Wonderful World – We will be thinking about the wonderful world that we live in. How special our planet is and why we need to look after it! We will also be thinking about our oceans and lands and the different wonders of the natural world.
- Sensational Skies – We will learn about our skies, our different weather systems and how they are formed. We will look beyond planet Earth to the moon and our solar system.
- Fabulous Fruit – This brings us back down to Earth! Where we will look at (and taste) lots of different fruits – look for seeds and plant them. We will think about what these seeds need to grow and experience planting and nurturing our own plants in class and outdoors.
