Please choose **2** of the following projects to complete linked to our topics this term; All About Me and Traditional Tales.

Alternatively, if you have a burning desire to complete a different related project, you can surprise your teacher with that instead.

Option 1: Create a self portrait

This could be created from anything, paint, drawing, objects around the house; be as creative as you want.

Think about the different features of your face, how many eyes do you have? What colour hair do you have?



Option 2: Where do you live?

Can you build a 3D model of your house? You could make this out of junk, bricks or Lego.

Think about how many windows your house has, how many doors. Does your house have a number?



Option 3: Create a timeline of your life

With your grownup, look at photos from when you were a baby to now. Using these photos, can you create a timeline of your life?

What do you notice about you? What has stayed the same? What has changed?

Special, friend, family, Mum, Dad, sister, brother, baby, toddler, child, house, features



Option 5: Role Play

Go to the library (or school) and borrow a copy of a traditional tale of your choice. Dress up as your favourite character from the story and video yourself in role. Take a photo or video and add it to Seesaw.



Option 4: Den building

Build a den for yourself and 3 bears (stuffed toys).

Use any materials that you can find at home or outside and take a photo or video and add it to Seesaw.



Option 6:

Set a table at home for the 3 bears to have breakfast.

How many spoons and bowls will you need? Will you provide them with a drink? Take a photo or video and add it to Seesaw.
