We will also continue to focus on using knives and forks when eating and trying to cut up food for ourselves.



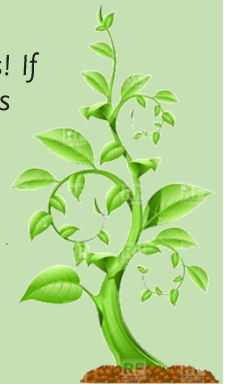
Seesaw
