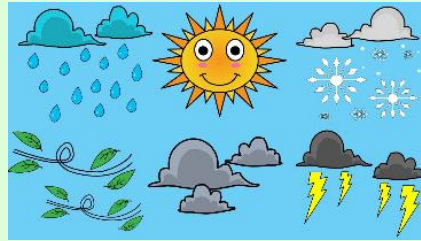
Option 2: Plant a Seed

Option 3: Weather Picture

Make a beautiful weather picture - rain, sun, clouds, rainbows.



Key Vocabulary:

Planet Earth, sea, sky, air, land, countries, people. Weather, rain, sun, cloud, fog, mist, rainbow. Plants, seed, roots, shoots, leaves, bud, flowers.



Option 5: Paper Aeroplane

Make a paper aeroplane and fly it. Measure how far it goes - can you modify your plane to make it fly further?



Option 4: Kite Flying

If it is windy, go outside and fly a kite. If you don't have a kite, can you make one?



Option 6: Exploring the Sky
