Please choose **2** of the following projects to complete, which are linked to our curriculum focuses this half term.

Alternatively, if you would like to complete different projects related to our topics, you can surprise your teacher with those instead.

Option 1 Science focus: Everyday Materials

Go on a treasure hunt in your house or outdoors to find everyday objects that are made of some of the following materials: wood, plastic, glass, metal, water and rock.

Next, can you conduct an experiment? Making predictions along the way. Here are lines of enquiry:

- Which materials float and sink?
- Which materials are absorbent?
- Which materials are waterproof?

Option 2 Art focus: Create a collage masterpiece!

Can you create a Christmas decoration using collage as the main artistic method?



Option 3 PSHE focus: Create a recipe for a good friend.

What do you value in a friendship? If you could make the 'perfect friend' what ingredients would you include? Think about important qualities you would like in a friend. A cup full of kindness? 50g of smiles?

A Recipe for Friendship

You will need:

- ♥ a pinch of happiness
- ♥ 1 handful of kindness
- ♥ 2 spoonfuls of gentleness
- ♥ 1 litre of sharing
- ♥ a teaspoonful of helpfulness
- ♥ 3 heaped tablespoons of laughter
- ♥ 50g of smiles
- ♥ a sprinkling of cheerfulness
- ♥ 100g of love



Method:

Mix all these together. Then you will have the perfect friend.



Option 4 History Focus: Ribblesdale School

Can you create a fact file (non-chronological report just like we have in English) about Ribblesdale High School and its history? Do you have a relation or family friend who attended there in the past that could tell you what school used to be like?
