Alternatively, if you have a burning desire to complete different projects related to our topics, you can surprise your teacher with those instead.


Option 1 Science focus: Omnivore, herbivore and carnivores.

Research which animals can be classed as omnivores, herbivores and carnivores and then create animal masks.



Option 2 Art focus: William Morris

Can you create an observational drawing of flowerheads using light and dark tones?



Option 3 Acrostic Poem

Can you create an acrostic poem of your name by using the letters to start each line?



Option 4 English focus: Peter Rabbit

Can you research the author of Peter Rabbit, then demonstrate what you know? You could create a Mr McGregor's garden from her books, create a fact file about Beatrix Potter, write a book review, role play one of the stories from her collection, or even visit the exhibition!
