Please choose **2** of the following projects to complete linked to our curriculum focuses this half term.

Alternatively, if you have a burning desire to complete different projects related to our topics, you can surprise your teacher with those instead.

Option 1 Science Focus: Plants

Draw and label the parts of a plant. Can you explain what each part is used for and how it helps the plant survive?



Option 2 DT Focus: Mechanisms

Can you design and make your own vehicle? It could be made from an old bottle or a cardboard box. Can you make it move?



Option 3 PSHE Focus: Living in the wider world.

Talk to someone at home about what you want to do when you grow up. Do you want to be a vet, a police officer or a fire fighter? Could you see yourself working in a shop or helping others fix things? What about an astronaut or a musician? Make a poster showing what job you would like as an adult and all the things you can do in that role.



Option 4 RE Focus: Devotion

Choose a person who is special to you. Create a poster explaining why they are special to you and how you show them they are special?

Option 5 Geography Focus: Hot and Cold Places.

Think about a place you have visited. Can you draw and label a picture of a place you have been that is hot and a place you have been that is cold?

What kinds of things did you see there? Include them in your picture. What kind of clothes would you wear in a hot place? What would you wear in a cold place? Can you add them to your picture?

Option 6 PE Focus: Gymnastics

Practise the balances you have been shown in your PE lessons. Can you balance on a small part of your body? Can you balance on a large part? Put together a sequence including a range of balances and rolls and ask a grown up to take a picture or film your sequence.
