Please choose **2** of the following projects to complete linked to our curriculum focuses this half term.

Alternatively, if you have a burning desire to complete different projects related to our topics, you can surprise your teacher with those instead.

Option 1 Science focus: Everyday materials

Explore the objects around your home and identify what they are made of. Do you have a material that has been used for a range of different purposes? Do you have any objects made from recycled materials? Draw or take photos of these objects and label what they have been made from.

Option 2 Art focus: Mixed media artists

Research Georgia O'Keeffe or Jeannie Baker and have a go at recreating one of their pictures. You can choose to use one type of media or use more than one.



Option 3 PSHE focus: Kind behaviour

Think about how you can show kind behaviours to others. Think about how it makes you feel if someone is kind or unkind towards you and how it might make others feel.

Create a kindness poster showing all the ways to be kind to people. Include ideas around how to get help if you need it.



Option 4 Computing focus: Digital photography

Using a digital camera, take a photo and upload it to Seesaw. Can you edit your image?

You could change the colour, add extra details or copy, cut or paste extra images.



Key vocabulary:

Unkind, kind, stranger, trusted adult, secrets, surprises, peer pressure, encouragement, material, natural, manmade, recycle, brittle, flexible, transparent, translucent, opaque.

Option 5 History focus: Bonfire night

Watch the fireworks on Bonfire night then create a firework picture. You could use paints, chalk, pencil crayons or make a 3D image using different materials.



Option 6 PE focus: Dance

Practise the moves taught within your lessons and create your own sequence of moves to a piece of music of your own choice. Remember to use expression when dancing to music.
